How It Works

1. Submit a Travel Concierge request through the website.
2. The independent partner contacts you directly.
3. You discuss options, pricing, fees, and terms with the partner.
4. Any booking agreement is made directly between you and the partner.

- Passport information if booking international travel
- Airline preferences or loyalty numbers

Frequently Asked Questions

Do I have to use the concierge?

No. You may book your own flights, hotels, insurance, and extensions.

Is airfare included?

No, unless a specific journey page explicitly says otherwise.

Who handles changes or cancellations?

The independent travel partner handles any reservation, fee, change, refund, or cancellation related to their service.
